RANCH CAMP

(campers completing 6th- 9th grade)

All riding levels are accepted at Ranch Camp! In the final weeks of the program, CIT's move into a cabin of younger campers to use their new skills to assist counselors. The CIT program is competitive, there are limited spaces and a separate application and interview is required.

CIT (COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING) For campers finishing grade 10 The CIT Program is a competitive program requiring a separate application, an interview and references. Enrollment in the CIT program is not guaranteed. Please call us for an application.

The rate for the CIT Program is \$3,150. This price includes the cost for the applicable stayover weekend.

OVERNIGHT CAMP ADD-ONS

Stayover Weekends (All ages)

If you are attending multiple sessions, you have the option of staying at camp for the weekend between sessions! Stays include laundry service, all meals and an off-site trip to Mountain Creek Waterpark on Saturday afternoon. Stayover weekend dates are: 7/6-7/7, 7/20-7/21 and 8/3-8/4. Price per weekend is \$135.

Horseback Riding (Ages 8+)

Choose between one or two week horseback riding lessons. There are 5 instructional periods per week for campers looking to improve their riding skills. For one week of lessons the price is \$130. Two weeks of lessons is only \$240.
